Fees and Payment

The tuition fee for the Summer School is **£975**. It covers access to library and computer facilities as well as tuition, course materials and refreshments. It does not cover accommodation or meals. Self-funded students, who are eligible for a discount of 30% on the fee, pay **£680**. UCL, Manchester and Edinburgh students, who are approved by the organisers to attend the TRSS, are exempted from paying the tuition fee.

Once students have been accepted for the course, they are responsible for paying the fee. Only those who have paid the fee will be guaranteed a place on the course and receive an admission letter, which can be used for visa application. Payment procedure details are available on the TRSS website.
